

## **Brown Bag Bible Study**



Our next Brown Bag Bible Study will begin Wednesday April 10th at 6pm. We'll study Adam Hamilton's book on the gospel of Luke titled "Jesus and the Outsiders, Outcasts, and Outlaws". Jesus came to uplift the lowly. Throughout his ministry to his final days on the road to the cross, we find stories of his relationships with ordinary, flawed, and unexpected people. He met,

dined, and traveled with people who were not perfect. Many of them were struggling, some were outsiders or even outlaws. Whoever they were, from those he healed to the outlaws with him at his crucifixion, Jesus brought the good news of God's kingdom to those who most needed to hear it.
